The Wellesley College Asian Association is sponsoring an annual "Blind Date Party" on Friday, November 6, 1987. The format of the party is as follows: Each participant of the "blind date" will be matched up with someone according to his or her interests, major, hobbies, etc. Everyone will meet at Alumnae Hall (where the party is held), and there, each person will be given the name of his or her blind date. It is then one's own responsibility to find his or her date. (In the mean time, this is a great way to meet many new people.) The participants will have two hours, from 7PM to 9PM to get to know their dates in a nice mixer atmosphere. We will be serving hors d'oeuvres and other kinds of "good food." Our dance will start at 9PM, and this is open to the public, including people who are not participating in the blind date. At this time, it is up to the individual couples to decide whether or not they would like to stay together; there is no obligation. The dance will be held from 9PM to 2AM. The Admission Fee to the Blind Date Party or the Dance is \$5. Participation in the blind date will enable you to get into the dance without an additional \$5.

In the past, most of the participants to our Blind Date Party were men and women from the greater Boston area schools and a few New York city schools. Our goal this year is to extend this event to more schools, and thus, offer everyone a chance to meet people from different colleges. We understand the need for overnight housing in order for some schools to come up for this event. Therefore, we will guarantee to house anyone with sufficient advanced notice. Please pass on the info of this event to members of your organization. We would be more than happy to hear your reply.

This event takes a lot of planning, therefore, we would greatly appreciate it if you would reply by phone as soon as possible. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at the above phone number. Because we are working under a time limit, late entrants are not guaranteed a date.
